- Exhibits are to be delivered to the VEOLIA ARENA Braidwood Road, Gate 5 on Wednesday 28 February before 6pm.
- Collection of exhibits will be from 4pm on Sunday 4th March until 5pm. Exhibits not collected by the close of the Arena may be collected from the show office on Monday afternoon between 2pm & 4pm.
- **Entry Fees:** \$5 per item
- **Prizes:** 1st \$10 2nd \$5

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each exhibitor is limited to 4 entries per class
- All exhibits must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor
- All exhibits must have been completed within the last 2 years
- Stewards have the right and final decision to alter the nominated category of any entry if a different class is deemed more applicable
- Art class, workshop & seminar pieces are acceptable.
- Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
