- **Entry forms and fees will be taken at the GOULBURN BASKETBALL STADIUM, Braidwood Road, Gate 5 from 11am to 6pm on Wednesday 21st February, Thursday 22nd, Friday 23rd then the last day will be Monday 26th February 2018 from 9am to 6pm.**
- Exhibits are to be delivered to the **VEOLIA ARENA** Braidwood Road, Gate 5 on Wednesday 28 February before 6pm.
- Collection of exhibits will be from 4pm on Sunday 4th March until 5pm. Exhibits not collected by the close of the Arena may be collected from the show office on Monday afternoon between 2pm and 4pm.
- **Entry Fees:** \$1 per item
- **Prizes:** 1st \$4 plus certificate, 2nd \$2 plus certificate

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each exhibitor is limited to 4 entries per class
- All exhibits must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor
- All exhibits must have been completed within the last 12 months
- Stewards have the right and final decision to place entries into a class other than that nominated by the entrant if there is a more suitable class available

CERAMICS AND MOSAICS

- 601.** Ceramics – functional – wheel thrown
- 602.** Ceramics – functional – hand-built
- 603.** Ceramics – sculptural form
- 604.** Mosaics – 2 Dimensional e.g. picture or mirror frame
- 605.** Mosaics – 3 Dimensional e.g. vase, flower pot, sculptural form

LEATHERWORK

- 606.** Belt, tooled, carved, stamped, filigree or other
- 607.** Bag, tooled, carved, stamped, filigree or other
- 608.** Leather whip, stock whip or other, any style
- 609.** Saddle, any style
- 610.** Picture (frame optional) or other illustrated object. May be carved, stamped, tooled, coloured with dyes or acrylics

WOODWORK

- 611.** Wood carving - one item
- 612.** Wood inlay or marquetry - one item
- 613.** Wood turning - one item
- 614.** Wooden box
- 615.** Musical instrument

FOLK AND DECORATIVE ART

- 616.** One item decorated with floral or other folk art motifs
- 617.** One item decorated with Australiana themed motifs art including flora, fauna etc

PAPER CRAFTS – DECOUPAGE

- 618.** Framed under glass - using traditional techniques under multiple coat varnish
- 619.** Any decoupaged object using traditional techniques under multiple coat varnish

PAPER CRAFTS – PAPIER MACHÉ

- 620.** Any item

PAPER CRAFTS – QUILLING

- 621. Wall hanging or picture, framed - must be paper only
- 622. Any other quilled item - frames, mounts or supports are allowed e.g. wood, wire

PAPER CRAFTS – SCRAPBOOKING

- 623. Traditional - journaling to predominate (at least one quarter of page recommended)
- 624. Single Photo - photo to be main focus of page - photo size 5 x 7 recommended
- 625. Multi Photo - must contain 3 or more photos – may include mosaic technique
- 626. Three Dimensional
- 627. Double Page - entries limited to one per exhibitor
- 628. Goulburn Show - page must contain photo(s) from any Goulburn Show

PAPER CRAFTS – OFF THE PAGE

- 629. Any article decorated using paper and embellishments - may include photographs

PAPER CRAFTS – CARDMAKING

- 630. Stamping - birthday or other folded greeting card featuring stamping as the main technique
- 631. Quilling - birthday or other folded greeting card featuring quilling as the main technique
- 632. Photographic - birthday or other folded greeting card incorporating photographs
- 633. General - birthday or other folded greeting card - any other technique

DOLLS AND TOYS

- 634. Porcelain doll - any style
- 635. Cloth doll or toy - any style
- 636. Creative mask - any material, any style

MODEL MAKING

- 637. Models – built from scratch – any medium

JEWELLERY AND BEADING

- 638. Beadweaving - wearable article including onloom and / or offloom techniques
- 639. Threadwork - wearable article made mostly with beads and beading thread and/or elastic
- 640. Wirework - wearable article using wire wrapping, coiling and / or wire threading techniques etc - may include beads or gemstones
- 641. Knitting and Crochet - wearable article constructed using knitting, crochet, macramé, knotting or plaiting techniques - may include beads or gemstones

FASHION ACCESSORIES

- 645. Millinery - must be a wearable fashion accessory for an adult female, any material
- 646. Handbag or shoulder bag - a fashion accessory for casual wear, business or evening wear

HOMEWARES

- 647. Most Creative Apron
- 648. Most Creative Tea Cosy
