Service NSW QR Code

Due to COVID-19 this year, somethings will be a little different

- Every person entering the grounds will be required to scan in at the gates with the Goulburn Show Service NSW QR Code. We encourage everyone to download the Service NSW App on your phone before you arrive. This is for COVID-19 contact tracing, if required.
- If visiting as a family or group, to speed up your entry, please add all group visitors as dependants to the Service NSW App before entering the show, you will be required to show the gate people that you have signed in on your phone.
- No phone or difficulties with scanning in? - We will have volunteers with tablets available at the gates to help you sign in.
- EFTPOS will be available at each gate and payment by card will be preferred.

Gates opening times

- All showground gates will be closed at 6pm each night and re-opened at 6am each morning, if you are requiring to come in overnight, Gate 2 Braidwood Road will be manned by security at night. Phone 0427281455 if you require any further information about getting in overnight or if gate is unattended.

Gate entry costs

• 1 day ONLY gate pass

Family \$30 (2 Adults - 2 Children) Single - \$15, Children \$5 (17 yrs. & under)

• 2 day COMPETITOR WEEKEND PASS which is great value

Family \$40 (2 Adults - 2 Children) Single \$20, Couples \$30 (2 Adults) Children \$10 (17 yrs. & under)

(Please display the COMPETITOR WEEKEND PASS in your vehicle window, so it can be seen by show committee)

Camping on the grounds

- There are NO yards available on the grounds.
- There is NO camping fee, only gate entry fee.
- Please note there is NO power available for horse competitors, please bring your own generator (If found to be plugged into any power, it will be removed and there will be a fee charged at \$20 a day which all other stall holders are required to pay) Please be considerate to others if you are running a generator.
- There are some water points scattered around the grounds, but very limited.
- Toilets and showers are available on site.
- Please make sure all garbage is placed in bins.
- Can all manure please be scatter around the grounds and not left in piles.
- All dogs to be on leads and contained at all times.
- Be aware that there are trotters in the same area as the horse events, they could be out working early in the morning, so please try and keep out of their way until they have finished usually about 9am.

Parking

• SPORTING

Sporting will be held over at the Rodeo Arena area, there is camping and parking in this area.

• SHOWJUMPERS

Please park on the outside of the trotting ring, in particular the big trucks, please be mindful to others wanting to park.

• HACKS, BREEDS, PONY CLUB, HARNESS ETC

Parking is available on the inside of the trotting track centre ring area, when parking please park nose in or tail in towards the ring.

- *ONLY PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS
- *PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU DO NOT PARK IN ROADWAYS OR ACCESS ROUTES
- *NOT PARALLEL TO THE HORSE RING
- *PLEASE ENSURE YOU PARK BEHIND THE BUNTED OFF AREAS
- *IF WET WEATHER PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF WHERE YOU PARK

Entering into horse events

Please make sure that you have read the Goulburn Show Horse Section Regulations

- **Property Identification Code**

A PIC number is required to enter all horses into the Goulburn Show, for further information.

- **Horse Health Declaration Form**

This form is to be completed by all horse exhibitors either by electronically or physically, printed off and handed in when buying horse entry tickets.

- **Waivers**

Waivers should be completed by anyone at your Show who is

- * Competing in horse events
- * Responsible for handling animals

They can either be electronically filled in or physically, printed off and must handed in when buying horse entry tickets.

- **Sporting**

Enter on the day, bring all completed paper work as noted above, to receive your arm band.

- **Showjumping**

- **Horse Ring events**

*Enter on the day at the horse ticket office.

*Please make sure you bring all completed paper work as noted above.

(Please make sure that we can read the information on the forms as we may need to use this information for when we are sending out results as requested)

*When you have presented your waiver, you will receive an arm band to identify that you have signed your waiver, you will not be allowed to enter the show ring without this on.

*When you present your Horse Health Declaration you will also get an identifying number that will relate back to you or your horse, that you will need to show the steward for them to record placings in the horse ring.

*All ring events are \$2 each (cash only) and you will receive a ticket that you will present to the steward when entering the horse ring.

*For spectator and competitor safety, only competitors will be allowed in the ring proper.

*Competitors are advised that the area in the middle of the centre ring is a throughfare only and is not to be used for a warm-up or exercise.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE

- **OTHER THAN ACCESSING THE RINGS VIA THE ALLOCATED CROSSINGS, RIDING OR LEADING HORSES ON THE GREYHOUND RACING TRACK IS ABSOLUTLEY PROHIBITED.**
- **DO NOT TIE ANIMALS TO THE RAIL AROUND THE CENTRE RING.**
