Conditions of Showing

- General regulations as per Goulburn Show Society
- Stud Classes open to Fullbloods registered with BGA or BGBAA
- Registration Papers to be available if needed on arrival
- Animals to be free of external parasites/lice & must not have any bald or open abscesses. Inspection on arrival
- Animals must remain on grounds until completion of Judging on Sun 7th March. Unless by special arrangement with the approval of the Administrators
- Limited space available for safe penning & exhibiting – Once area full entries may be declined or asked to reduce numbers.
- Age to be calculated from day of show 6th March 2021
- No Stud insignia to be worn/visible in ring during judging
- All exhibits must have NLIS compliant tag
- Classes may be altered depending on numbers of entries
- Classes with less than 3 entries will be merged with an adjoining class or sectioned cancelled
- Any Class with greater than 12 entries will be considered to add a Class as feasible
