- * All exhibits **must** have their Goulburn AP&H Entry Labels securely attached to the back of the artwork.

Pencil, Charcoal, Conte, Pen & Ink, etc. May include mixed media/collage elements

DIGITAL GENERATED ART

Computer generated image to be presented in a format suitable for hanging

- 10009** Any Subject

PRINT MAKING

- 10010** Printmaking - Any subject, any technique - etching, drypoint, lino cut, monoprint, collagraph, etc.

SCULPTURE

Maximum weight 50kg. Maximum height 2 metres (including any plinth).

Must not exceed 1 square metre in base area. Supply of a plinth is optional.

Choice of plinth, colour and size at the discretion of the exhibitor.

Plinth must be labelled with the exhibitor's name under the base.

If no plinth is provided by the exhibitor, the structure will be displayed on the floor or a table.

- 10011** Sculpture - Any Medium - stone, metal, wood, resin, cement, clay or mixed media.

Any technique - carving, casting, modelling or mixed media assemblage.

These works will be displayed in the Veolia Arena.

SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS - This section is for senior groups, aged care, disability groups etc.

- 10012** Any painting or drawing
CARERS please ensure you assist your clients to present their art works ready for hanging. Any special interest groups work unable or unsuitable to be hung will be displayed on tables or in racks if available.
