- \* No exhibit to be entered in more than one category and must have been completed in the last 2 years and not been exhibited at a previous Goulburn Show
- \* A limit of 4 items in each category per exhibitor
- \* Categories may be split at the judge's discretion
- \* **PLEASE NOTE: All entries falling outside judging requirements will be displayed, but may not be judged**

- 5004 Any other item of Baby Knitting, including Pram Covers, Blankets or Shawls
- 5005 Garment for a Child - 7 ply or finer. Pullover, Cardigan, Jacket, Dress etc. Any technique
- 5006 Garment for a Child - 8 ply or thicker. Pullover, Cardigan, Jacket, Dress etc. Any technique
- 5007 Garment for an Adult - 7 ply or finer. Pullover, Cardigan, Jacket, Dress etc. Any technique
- 5008 Garment for an Adult - 8 ply or thicker. Pullover, Cardigan, Jacket, Dress etc. Any technique
- 5009 Shawl or Wrap for an Adult. Any technique. Any ply
- 5010 Scarf or Cowl for an Adult. Any technique. Any ply
- 5011 Knitted Accessories for an Adult. Can include mittens, gloves, hats or socks etc
- 5012 Knitted Travelling or Knee Rug (Size no larger than 120cm x 120cm)

- 5021 Crocheted Shawl or Wrap for an Adult. Any ply

## EMBROIDERY WORK, CANVAS WORK and TAPESTRY

FRAMED WORK SHOULD BE NO LARGER THAN 70cm x 60cm

- 5030 Long Stitch Canvas Work or Tapestry Framed, work should be no larger than 70cm x 60cm
- 5031 Cross Stitch Canvas Work or Tapestry, Framed, work should be no larger than 70cm x 60cm
- 5032 Any Other Item of Canvas Work or Tapestry not mentioned above, Framed, work should be no larger than 70cm x 60cm
- 5033 Cross Stitch Embroidery, must be presented in completed format on CLOTH, **not CANVAS, not FRAMED**
- 5034 Surface Embroidery, for example, Crewel, Stamped or Transfer Embroidery, etc.
- 5035 Stumpwork and/or 3 Dimension Embroidery
- 5036 Hardanger and/or Drawn Thread Embroidery
- 5037 Wool Embroidery
- 5038 Creative Embroidery
- 5039 Bag or Cushion using any/or a combination of Embroidery Techniques
- 5040 Any Other Item of Embroidery not mentioned above

**NO MAX SIZE REQUIRED**

- 5041 Quilt - Primarily Pieced, by maker, machine quilted or other
- 5042 Quilt - Predominately Appliquéd
- 5043 Patchwork Cushion, may include appliqué and embroidery
- 5044 Patchwork Bag, may include appliqué and embroidery
- 5045 Any Other Item of Quilting, which may include wall hangings or table runners, not mentioned above
