- * Pavilion **entries** will also be taken at the GOULBURN BASKETBALL STADIUM, Braidwood Road, Gate 4 on Saturday 29th February & Sunday 1st March 2020 from 12noon to 4pm.
Monday 2nd March & Tuesday 3rd March 2020 from 10am to 6pm.
- * Pavilion **exhibits** to be delivered to either Goulburn Basketball Stadium or the Veolia Arena by 6pm on Wednesday 4th March before 6pm, except produce and cookery should be delivered to the pavilion before 6pm on Thursday 5th March and also flowers which can be staged up until 8.45 am on Saturday 7th March.
- * Most judging to take place on Friday 6th March 2020.
- * Prizes will be ribbons unless otherwise stated.
- * There are no entry fees for junior classes unless otherwise stated.
- * Collection of exhibits will be from **4pm on Sunday 8th March 2020 until 5pm**. Exhibits not collected by the close of the pavillion may be collected from the Veolia Arena on Monday 9th March from 9am to 5pm.
