

Goulburn AP&H Society 2020 Show – Table Wine

Conditions of Entry

The Goulburn Show Committee will accept wine entries for judging at this year's Show subject to the following conditions.

Eligibility

The show will be open to all producers in the Merino Country Vignerons' Association area. This has as its boundary the neighbouring GI Wine Regions of the Southern Highlands, Canberra, Shoalhaven and Hilltops. Producers must hold a current Producer/Wholesaler liquor licence.

Wines must be made from grapes sourced from within the Merino Country area.

All entries must conform to the relevant standards and regulations that govern wine production in Australia and hold and conform to the conditions pertaining to their Producer/Wholesaler licence.

Classes

Entries will be accepted for finished, commercially bottled wines in two classes, namely:

- Class 1 - White table wine
- Class 2 - Red table wine

A given wine shall only be entered once, but an exhibitor may enter any number of wines in any one class and receive more than one award in that class.

Stock

The producer must have a minimum of 10 dozen of each wine available for sale at the time of entry. Two 750 ml bottles of each wine entered must be delivered for judging. In the case of fortified wines, two 375ml bottles are sufficient for entry. These will remain the property of the Goulburn AP&H Society Inc.

Timetable

- Judging will be on a date TBA in the two weeks leading up to the show on 7th/8th March.
- Wines and awards will be on display at the show on Sat 7th and Sun 8th March 2020

Judging

Wines will be judged by Nick Bulleid, Master of Wine, who will determine the first, second and third best wines in each class. The judge may choose not to award some or all of the places if the wines are found to be insufficient in number or quality.

Entry Fee

\$10 per entry is to be submitted with the entry form. Payment can be made by cheque or direct bank deposit. Cheques should be made payable to Goulburn AP&H Society Inc.
