Conditions of Entry:

Horses may ONLY enter two classes at CONSECUTIVE heights each day.

A horse / rider combination may enter only one class in concurrent classes (a or b).

A junior rider is a rider who has not passed 18 years at the end of the calendar year of the competition.

Amateur classes will be conducted in accordance with the Jumping NSW Series requirements. Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that has, or will compete in any class higher than 1.20m at the Show.

All horses entered in 1.05m or above must hold current registration and competitors licence from EA. All registration details must be provided before competing.

The event will be run under FEI / EA rules.

All stallions MUST be identified with the current national identification disc.

All prize presentations will be mounted.

Summer Uniform will be permitted if weather conditions require. If riding without a coat, proper riding shirts with tie or ratcatcher will be permissible. Short sleeve shirts are acceptable, sleeveless aren't.

50% refunds will be given on presentation of doctor's certificate or veterinary certificate.

The Organising Committee reserves the right, at its absolute discretion to vary any aspect of the event.

Protests must be lodged to the Ground Jury in writing, accompanied by a \$50 fee, within 30 minutes of results.

The event is held in support of the Goulburn AP&H Society Annual Show. All competitors will be required to pay Show entry fees in addition to riding fees.
