Angora Goat unloading will be through Gate 6 on Braidwood Road. This gate opens from 6am and all vehicles to be moved offsite to parking areas by 8.30am.

All exhibits must remain on the showground until 5pm on the day of exhibition.

- **Goat Health Declaration and Exhibitor Indemnity and Waiver forms** must be completed and posted/handed to the Chief Steward.
- Stud Angoras must be registered in the name of the exhibitor who shall be an owner listed in a herd book recognized by the Goulburn Show Society and Mohair Australia Ltd and be in ownership 30 day prior to the show.
- All tattoos must be legible, all animals to be free of contagious diseases and complaints. All animals must be free of foot rot. Herds from zoned residual areas must present market assurance certificate.
- Exhibitors not eligible for animal classes may enter fleece classes.
- Mohair fleeces to be presented at the Pavilion by 9am for judging at 9.30am.
- Angora goats will be judged at the conclusion of fleece judging.
- Every attendant, while parading an exhibit before a judge, shall wear a clean white dust coat which must not carry any insignia or marking which may identify the exhibitor.

To be judged as a group

ANGORA GOATS YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION

Competition will commence at 1:30pm (after completion of judging)

Entries to be lodged with the chief steward.

No entry fee is required and no prize money.

Competitors will be asked to judge a group of animals and a group of fleeces.

Placing of competitors will be determined by the steward comparing contestant's results to the judge's results.

Judge will explain all his decisions for the benefit of contestants.

Winner will compete for state championships at Sydney Royal.

A ribbon will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places at the Goulburn Show.

Entries are open to competitors 25 years and under.
